Rules of Play

<u>Format</u> – Four-person scramble. Shotgun start. Each team member tees off in any order. Pick the best shot and play from that point. Continue this procedure until the ball is holed.

Seniors (60+) and Ladies – Please Play GREEN Tees Gentlemen – Please Play WHITE Tees

<u>Preferred Lies</u> – please lift, clean, and place the ball anywhere through the green within one club length. If the team elects to play a ball from the hazard the ball must be dropped.

<u>Mulligans</u> – may be purchased (\$10 donation) from the clubhouse or a tournament volunteer throughout the day. Limit Two (1 per side). Please use the honor system for mulligans.

<u>Bogey is Your Partner</u> – the highest score a team should take is a bogey. This helps move things along for the whole field.

<u>Tie Breakers</u> – Countback, the combined back 9 scores are compared to determine a winner. If still tied, then the last 6 totals are compared, then the last 3, then the last hole until a winner can be determined.


